Fall Watering Restrictions

SEPT. 1 - OCT. 31

It's time to change your watering clock. Fall mandatory watering restrictions are in effect from September through October. Water grass on your 3 assigned days a week. Drip irrigated plants and trees need much less water than grass, run drip systems just two days a week (recommended). That's all it takes. And don't forget, never water on Sunday.

Nevada [law](#) prohibiting the use of Colorado River water to irrigate nonfunctional grass takes effect Jan. 1, 2027. If you haven't already, replace your useless grass now and receive cash incentives to help your water smart landscape conversion. Apply for rebates at snwa.com.
